Voted unanimously to accept Dec. minutes as amended.

Bob L. will send last year's minutes to Bob D. so he can write the annual report.

Bob D. will revitalize the effort to set up a Google-based Web site for the Commission. We agreed that posting our minutes on-line would be beneficial.

Voted unanimously to pay G.W. Shaw & Son, Inc. \$716.30 for dumpsters used for final cleanup at the Potter homestead. Money to come from the Land Protection Fund.

Voted unanimously to pay Cornerstone Excavation \$1,260.00 for demolition and site cleanup at Potter homestead. Money to come from Land Protection Fund.

Voted unanimously to pay Global Remediation Services, Inc. \$575.00 for testing barrel contents at Potter homestead. Money to come from Land Protection Fund. Agreed not to work with this company again. The final bill was quite a bit higher than their estimate, and the service was not satisfactory.

Voted unanimously to pay New England Disposal Technologies \$647.03 for disposal of "oily liquid" in plastic barrels at the Potter homestead. Note that we were very pleased with their price and courteous, fast service.

Received A-frame rental check from Dennis Graham (\$1200).

Voted unanimously to pay the Boy Scouts \$600, \$400 from the Land Protection Fund and \$200 from the General Fund. The \$200 was received from donations as described in Dec. 2009 minutes.

Voted to authorize Oakridge Sign to produce signs for three conservation lands at a cost of roughly \$300.
